


ONLINE WEB TOOL → <http://oregon.ctepathways.org>

- The Career Pathways Roadmap Web Tool was developed in 2007 by the Oregon Pathways Alliance, a collaboration of Oregon's 17 community colleges. Since its initial development, users have recommended continual improvements and upgrades which have been implemented over time. Each roadmap includes common information elements, and follows standards so that roadmaps have a similar look across the state. The Web Tool makes it easy to develop and revise roadmaps quickly and to track versions to provide Career Pathways roadmaps for students, advisors, and counselors.
- The online Web Tool is ADA compliant. Lane Community College provides the development, training, online help, and technical assistance for the Web Tool.
- Each community college is set up with users to manage and publish their own collection of roadmaps, while having access to view all roadmaps created at the 17 community colleges across the state of Oregon.
- More than 350 Career Pathways roadmaps have been developed. To view the roadmaps if you don't have an account on the Web Tool, go to the link above and click on the *Guest Login*.
- "POST (Plan of Study Templates) Drawings" is the newest feature of the Web Tool developed to map high school and community college plans of study. This POST feature was coordinated and piloted by Lane ESD in 2008-09, and released in April 2009.
- Customized, regional, onsite training session are available at no cost upon request for both the Roadmap and POST features. Customized webinars are also available for your college or school on topics that meeting your training needs and at times that work for you.

- **Career Pathways for Job Seekers:** As of July 2009, published Career Pathways Roadmaps are now available on OLMIS Occupational Reports. OLMIS pulls data from the Career Pathways Web Tool on a nightly basis to assure that new and updated roadmaps are available for job seekers and WSO/WIB staff.
